Pasteurized Donor Human Milk for Outpatient Use

Mothers' Milk Bank of Tennessee established the Compassionate Care Fund to waive processing fees to qualifying households. The fund was established thanks to the generosity of our financial donors and corporate supporters.

All requests for pasteurized donor milk and financial assistance are evaluated on an individual basis. Since we rely on the generosity of volunteer milk donors and financial donors, we cannot guarantee availability of pasteurized donor human milk or financial assistance. Requests will be fulfilled based on availability of donor milk and financial donations.

Families may qualify if:

- You currently participate in a federal assistance program such as WIC, SNAP, live in subsidized housing or receive other public assistance.
- You are experiencing an unexpected and/or urgent financial burden.
- You meet the income eligibility requirements below.

Income Eligibility

(200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines for 2025)

| Family Size | Annual Income |
|--------------------|----------------------|
| One | \$0- \$31,300 |
| Two | \$31,301- \$42,300 |
| Three | \$42,301- \$53,300 |
| Four | \$53,301- \$64,300 |
| Five | \$64,301- 75,300 |
| Six | \$75,301- 86,300 |
| Seven | \$86,301- 97,300 |
| Eight | \$97,301- 108,300 |

Add \$11,000 of allowable income for each additional family member.
